Forthcoming Synods in Ireland and in Universal Church

The entire Catholic Church is called to take part in the upcoming Synod of Bishops (October 2023). This Synod is entitled: "For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation and Mission.

Pope Francis has called the entire People of God to journey together. This Synod is not just another meeting with written reports. This Synod is a process of journeying together by listening, talking, praying, discerning and making decisions together for the purpose of proclaiming the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

Pope Francis is asking each local diocese to gather – clergy, religious and laity together- to listen to each other. The goal of our journeying together is to listen and learn with each other, and to grow closer to the Lord and His Church.

Parish Participation

Pope Francis wants to hear from the whole Church about what is happening in local parishes. He and the bishops would like to know what individuals think we should all be doing to help make our parishes better. The way he has proposed doing this is a synodal process. Synod means "journeying together" and it involves listening to the Holy Spirit and to each other to discern the path we are called to walk together. By the end of this journeying together process it is hoped to capture everyone's answers to the basic question: **What is the Holy Spirit saying to our Church today.**

In order to ensure the voices of our parishioners are included in the Synod we will be issuing 2 questions to all parishioners and all replies will be collated and returned to the Diocese to be included in the Diocesan response.

Next weekend we will be issuing postcards for you to write your replies on; this can be done in the Church or you may take it home with you to complete at home. Either way a box will be provided in the porch of each Church for your completed postcards.

The questions we are posing are:

- 1. The love of God is for everyone do you think everyone is welcomed and supported in the Church today? If not who do you think is left out?
- 2. As the Holy Spirit helped the Apostles to go out and spread the Good News after the Ascension; what steps do you think He is calling us to take today to spread the Good News?

Please above all pray to the Holy Spirit for the success of these Synods
