Blessed Carlo Acutis is soon to be made a Saint!

A declaration last Thursday from the Vatican has announced that another miracle has been attributed to the intercession of <u>Carlo Acutis</u>, meaning he will be canonized. The miracle involved the healing of a young woman, 21, from Costa Rica, studying in Florence, Italy, who fell from her bicycle in July of 2022. She incurred a severe head injury. She was taken to the hospital, where her skull was opened to relieve pressure on the brain, but her situation was critical. The accident occurred on July 2, 2022, and a coworker of the girl's mother immediately began to pray to <u>Blessed Carlo</u>. Six days later, the mom went to Assisi to pray at Blessed Carlo's tomb. That same day, the girl began to breathe on her own. Within 10 days, she was discharged from ICU. Renewed thanks to those who gave donations towards the costs of the visit.
